The tool uses 2000 and 2009 census data to compare the demographic characteristics of lower-income and higher-income neighborhoods within a city. It also provides aggregate information for New England states and for the region as a whole. From detailed analyses to a one-page summary, the tool makes census data accessible to everyone.



New England City Data provides three useful ways to access the data:

City Summary

The City Summary provides a snapshot of the city's key variables for easy viewing, downloading in PDF format, and printing. Find summary tables and charts of selected indicators for 2000 and 2009 for LMI and MUI areas in the city and state that interest you.

City Tables


